

Performer/storyteller/singer-songwriter, Dawn Larsen, grew up in the Ozarks amid lots of mountain music, arts, storytelling, beautiful hills and rivers. She taught herself to play guitar at 13. At a family gathering at about that age, after she had finished singing traditional ballads and was taking a break, her mother pulled her aside and asked, "Don't you know anything besides death and dying music?" She's proud to play Americana music, which is full of "death and dyin," an integral part of the human condition.

Dawn's solo shows and music seem to speak to audiences, handling emotional subjects with grace and comedy. She writes about her experiences. She released two CDs, the first *The Vicious Hillbilly*, 10 original songs that a fan described as: "Part Patty Griffin... part Todd Snider...part Linda Ronstadt...ALL honest, soulful lyrics combining Americana, alt-Country, Blues, and Folk musical styles while exploring life as a progressive hillbilly girl living in the deep south." The second in 2019 inspired by her homeland, the Ozarks, *Hillbillyland*.

She incorporates her songs and stories into solo shows, The Vicious Hillbilly or Dating in the Deep South, a Tale of Woe in Story and Song that toured in the US from 2018-2020, Granny's FixIt about grannywomen in the Ozarks, and Corn Under Canvas: An Evening With a Tent Show Actress. Her lyric-driven music, as well as humorous stories that accompany the songs, are a perfect fit to listening environments.
